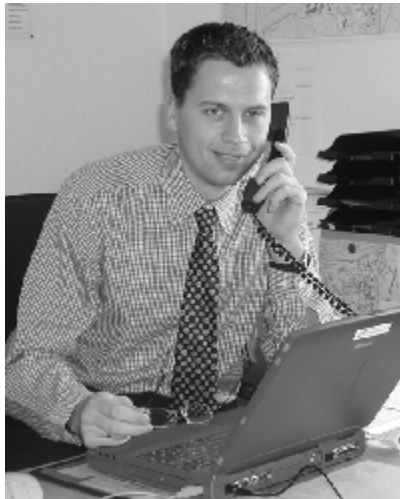

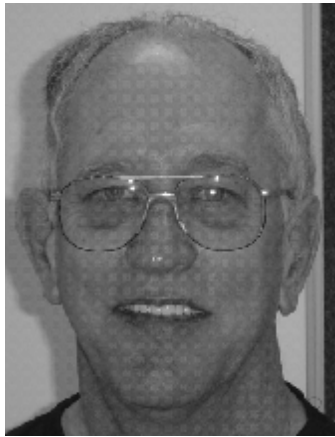
Lasantha is a member of the Alumni Association of the Institute of Air and Space Law of McGill University, Montreal, Canada.

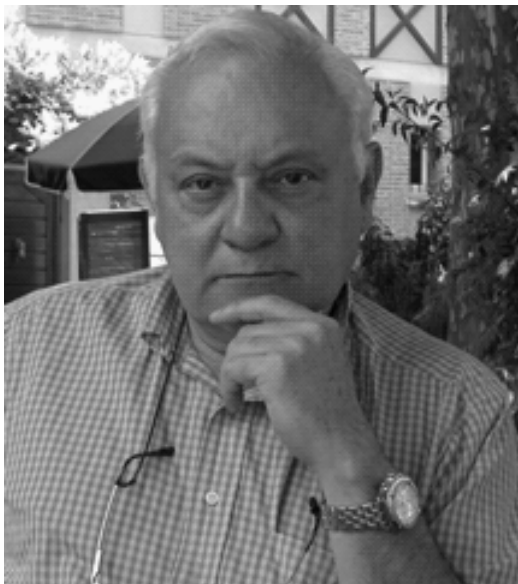
